

## **Council Statement: Updates on Orientation Programme for AY16/17**

The 25th Nanyang Technological University Students' Union (NTUSU) Council has decided on a response to the Orientation 2016 structure proposed by the University Orientation Coordination Committee (UOCC). The decision was made during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Council Meeting, held on 22nd September 2015, by the 37 council representatives from various academic and non-academic constituent clubs. The hall Junior Common Room Committees' (JCRC) representatives were also invited to the meeting to give their inputs on the matter.

The 25th NTUSU Council has held two special council meetings in the past two weeks to discuss about the proposal and the response. The UOCC will consider the NTUSU's response and other inputs from hall fellows and college representatives before making a final decision.
